The proposed plan for no. 5. is without care for the neihgbourhood.  The proposed extension on ground floor level is next to the party wall in the garden and even if it would consist of a glass structure, it would cause loss of light and loss of privacy.  There is an approximately 40-45 centimetres wide existing gap between the existing kitchen of No.5 and the garden wall. Its loss would be detrimental to our source of light.  The exisiting kitchen was built without planning permisision by a previous owner, while we were away. We have lost a great amount of light.  The proposed first floor exension in No. 5. Back Lane is an eyesore. Not at all in character with the Victorian porperties and would also create loss of light to us, at first floor level.  When Mr Loewi's previous application for en extension of his property towards the garden was refused in the 1990s, he asked if we would agree to a top floor extension instead.  To keep good relations we did not oppose it having built.  Now, he submitted an entirely different plan, an enlargement towards the garden. This would have an enclosing effect on our property.
