Thanks.</p> <p>The applicant has already applied and been denied a roof terrace on a lower flat roof which badly overlooks our garden however the applicant has gone ahead anyway and created a roof terrace that is currently in use in clear breach of permission given, (for a Juliet balcony). Despite the enforcement officer asking her to revert the scheme, I have received an email from the applicant stating that they have no intension of reverting the scheme. The enforcement officer has told me that the applicant is in "clear breach" as "The works are not in accordance with the approved drawings" and he has told her to revert the scheme.</p> <p>Could i ask please that permission for this upper roof terrace application 2016/6650/P is denied until the applicant reverts to the approved scheme 2015/4502/P. It seems to me that this would be the only way that the applicant could be persuaded to abide by the rules. If the applicant instals a proper Juliet balcony on the lower flat roof FIRST then i shall be unlikely to object to the upper roof terrace application.
