### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) T1 -self-set -fell to ground level and grind out stump

1 x Cherry (*Prunus*) T2 -raise canopy by 1.5m-remove dead ivy from main stem

1 x Laburnum T3 -remove outer tall stem to main low trunk, remove all dead ivy from remaining stems

1 x Sycamore (*Acer pseudoplatanus*) T4 -reduce crown by 35% -remove all dead ivy for main stems and branches, shape to balance and tidy

2 x Western Red Cedar (*Thuja plicata*) T5 & T6- fell to ground level, grind out both stumps and raised buttress roots to 300mm below ground level for re-landscaping

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 02 November 2016 and does not wish to object.


- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
