
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Site Plan



3D view of the rear of the building as existing.




After meeting with the Planning Officers and a Heritage and Conservation Officer the design was updated to retain more of the layout. The internal spaces were retained as far as possible and the extension is to be of lightweight construction adjacent to the closet wing.



2 Original Proposal

After discussions with our Planning Officer, we ameded the design to a brick rear extension, similar to that of 54 Delancey Street. This provided a roof terrace to the flat above.



Revised Proposal Option 2

The Senior Heritage and Conservation Officer requested that we reduce the design to be 'lightweight and subordinate in form... amending the closet wing with a moderate amount of increase in height and depth". We followed the further advice of the Planning Officer to explore a similar extension as 48 Delancey Street.
