At the time I was told that Camden Council had already granted permission for these works to proceed which was and is clearly not true. This was unethical behaviour and well below any level of expected professional conduct anyone ought to reasonably expect under such circumstances. 2) The recent report concerning sun and daylight availability to the island block in Holsworthy Square is too generalised using words like "less", "little". It quantifies nothing. As you know there is an acceptable level of sunlight/daylight reduction recognised in law and it is impossible as it stands to tell whether my property falls into this category or not because no actual figures are given. 3) A recent document, however, submitted by the applicant states that"some" rooms in Holsworthy Square is obviously significantly different from the abstract notion of a 'little' reduction in light.
