**Re: 5-7 Lambolle Road, London NW3 4HS**

The following tree numbers correspond to those on the attached tree location plan.

	<b><u>SPECIES</u></b>	<b><u>WORK PROPOSED</u></b>
1	Lime <i>(Tilia spp)</i>	Large mature tree not maintained for some time now. To contain spread and improve light, space and clearance all round:  Reduce crown all round 25-30% to previous reduction points, retain crown continuity. Thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches and sucker regrowth. Lift canopy all round by up to 2m and balance crown.
2	Laurel <i>(Prunus spp)</i>	Large mature tree/shrub. To contain spread, improve light all round and re-balance. Reduce and reshape crown 1-2m all round. Thin and clean out crown, remove deadwood. Lift and balance crown.
3	Holly <i>(Ilex aquifolium)</i>	Mature tree. To contain spread and improve light, space and clearance all round. Reduce and reshape crown by 1-2m all round, lift and level off 'browse line'. Balance crown

4	Laurel	<i>(Prunus spp)</i>	As for item 2 above
5	Holly	<i>(Ilex aquifolium)</i>	Very large mature free standing tree. To contain spread and improve light, space and clearance all round. Reduce and reshape crown by up to 2m all round and level off 'browse line', balance crown.
6	London Plane	<i>(Platanus x hispanica)</i>	Very large mature tree with dense multistem crown. As for item 1 above.
9	Osmanthus		Suggest: Reduce and reshape crown by up to 2m all round. Thin and cleanout crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches. Lift canopy all round by 1-2m and balance crown.
13	Lime	<i>(Tilia spp)</i>	Young tree. Lift and prune back over garden 1-2m.
15	Ash	<i>(Fraxinus excelsior)</i>	Self set tree. Very poor location. Remove now before it becomes a problem tree as it grows much bigger.
