Until recently this was an unspoilt and special corner of the Conservation Area.

It is a pity that this large dwelling, which detracts from the Conservation Area, was ever approved - with two basements (!!).

Any attempt to increase its size and height or the extent of garden excavation should be firmly resisted.

It is unclear what change(s) the application is requesting.

Actually the only change shown on the drawings is the proposed access to a large flat roof - ideal for use as a terrace which would create serious overlooking and noise problems for neighbours.

Such use would not be controllable by planning or any other law or regulation.

Please therefore refuse completely.
