Re: LinkUK from BT Planning Submissions at 21 Locations following Pre-application Enquiry 2016/3367/PRE

Following the pre-application advice received from you and your colleagues on 28 proposals, I have the pleasure of submitting formal applications for Full Planning Permission and Express Advertisement Consent for proposals at 21 locations across the borough, as per the attached schedule, on behalf of our client LinkUK from BT.

Additional Information Following Pre-application Feedback

The following additional documentation and information was requested following the preapplication enquiry:

- details of the removal of additional existing BT telephone kiosks outside of the application sites;
- details of the proposed operating conditions for the advertisement screens, specifically with regard to the nature of advertisements (i.e. static or video), luminance levels, duration of each image, transitions between images and oblique viewing angle information;
- details of the mitigation of any highway safety impact of the advertisement screens and justification thereof;



- a detailed demonstration of the proposed positions on the footway and the resultant footway widths in each case; and,
- confirmation that, where more than one Link unit is proposed on the same road (Camden High Street, High Holborn etc.), that no two units would be readily visible from the same viewpoint.

Removal of Additional Kiosks

Further to our ongoing correspondent on this matter, it is proposed that additional removals be secured via a Section 106 agreement tied to the planning permissions at an agreed ratio. It was agreed to finalise the Section 106 during the formal application process.

Proposed Operating Conditions of the Advertisement Screens

Full details in relation to the points raised at pre-app in this regard are included in the attached additional document 'Proposed Schedule of Operating Conditions - LinkUK from BT Advertisement Screens'.

Mitigation of Highway Safety Impact

Information on the mitigation of any highway safety impact is also contained in the document 'Proposed Schedule of Operating Conditions - LinkUK from BT Advertisement Screens'.

Resultant Available Footway Widths

The Link unit is 100mm narrower than the existing kiosks. Consequently, all existing useable footway widths would increase as a result of the replacement. Additionally, wherever practical, the Link unit has been repositioned closer to the curb edge (generally to 200mm from the curb) to increase the available footway from that which exists at present with the existing kiosk in place. In many cases the available footway would be significantly increased. An additional plan at 1:200 is included for each proposal, in addition to an elevation at 1:100 which together make this clear in each case.



Avoiding Visual Overlap of Multiple Link Locations on the same Road

Those locations identified as having the potential for visual overlap at pre-app have been assessed and there is considered to be only one pair of Link locations at which this would be an issue; those being the following:

- Camden High Street (outside JP Pharmacy no 139)
- Camden High Street (outside unit 1, 112-114 Game)

As discussed, LinkUK from BT would like to seek consent for both of these locations on the understanding that only one consent would be implemented; a condition being added to each permission to secure this limitation. This is to mitigate against any delays caused by potential technical issues with either location at a later stage; i.e. one site would act as a back-up option should the other prove problematic.

Negative Pre-application Responses

20 of the 21 locations received a broadly positive response at pre-app. The proposal at Camden High Street (outside HSBC, junction Parkway) received a broadly negative response but it is considered that its impact could be made acceptable by additional kiosk removals, as discussed. As such, the decision has been taken to put it forward for formal submission with a view to mitigating its impact through the Section 106 process.
