Front left

T2 Purple leaf Plum x

(Prunus cerasifera

Mature tree. This tree is diseased. There is a Ganoderma applanatum fungal bracket at the base of the tree to the Southeast. This fungus is a root and butt rotter that causes delignification. The end result is mechanical failure of the butt and/or trunk. Given the location of the tree and the potential targets, the suggested works are: To fell to ground level by sectional takedown.

Front right

T3 Horse Chestnut x 1

(Aesculus hippocastanum)

Large, mature, previously reduced tree. To maintain the tree, the suggested works

are: To reduce back to the previous points of reduction, retain shortened furnishing growth for crown continuity, clean out crown, remove deadwood.

Rear right

T4 Himalayan Birch x (Betula utilis)

Mature, previously reduced tree. To maintain the tree, the suggested works are: To reduce back to the previous points of reduction, retain shortened furnishing

growth for crown continuity, remove deadwood.
