The site plan drawings are incomplete and seem to show the proposed cctv poles at the entrance to the garage and bin store at ground floor (there are no doors at first floor level). Is it possible to see accurate plans? Also, there is no details of surface fixed trunking, colour and materials proposed. Without this information we cannot determine if this application complies with Camden planning policies.
