The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed development by virtue of its detailed design, size and location would appear as an incongruous addition that would have an adverse impact on the character and appearance of the host building, the terrace of which it forms a part, and the surrounding area. The proposal is therefore contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP24



(Securing high quality design) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies, and policy 2 (Design and character) of the Fortune Green & West Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
