Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The CCTV cameras, by reason of their visibility, positioning, size and scale are considered inappropriate and visually intrusive elements that would detract from the special architectural interest of the grade I listed building contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
