Proposed Work:

WITHIN MECKLENBURGH SQUARE: 1 x Lime - Reduce crown by 2-3m all round by thinning branch ends 30-35%, clean out crown, remove deadwood, weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Lift canopy all round by 1-2m and remove epicormic growth.
1 x Sycamore - Remove the 3 lowest branches over Mecklenburgh Square garden. Lift and prune lateral spread over the W.C to improve clearance by 2-3m. Clean out crown, remove weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Balance crown.
2 x Lime - Clean out crown. Remove all weak and suppressed branches and sucker regrowth. Lift canopy all round by 1-2m, level off 'browse line' and balance crown.
1 x Cherry - Reduce and reshape crown by up to 2m all round by thinning branch ends 30-35% lessening weight and stress. Clean out crown, remove weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Lift canopy all round by 1-2m, level off 'browse line' and balance crown.

1 x Cherry - Clean out crown, remove weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Lift canopy all round by up to 1m all round. Balance crown.
