I find this proposal totally unacceptable.

The current premises provide an active shop front to the street with waiting areas reception and activity.

The reception and the treatment rooms benefit from excellent daylight from the front window and rooflights! There is benefit to patients to be treated in daylight especially for complex procedures.

The basement has no natural light and low cramped ceilings, not suitable for good artificial light and for dentists equipment!
