Dear Kate,

As the residents of No 8 Fitzroy Park we wish to endorse the email sent by our neighbour at No 8A Fitzroy Park, Coline McConville, in objection to this application.

We would add that our house is built high up above the road with a retaining wall all around our garden perimeter. This follows a steep, blind corner - below which our garage forecourt provides up hill access to the road - and the sewers from our property enter into the main system in the road at this junction. Access into the road is already difficult here as it is impossible to see or hear cyclists, pedestrians and other vehicles. A steady stream of HGVs will aggravate this and together with the narrowness of the road puts our essential retaining wall at risk as well as other road users.
