The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The loss of the existing coach doors and Collinge hinges and their replacement with full height bi-folding doors, by virtue of the scale, location and detailed design will have a detrimental impact on the character and appearance of the host building, would appear as incongruous additions within the row of mew properties and results in harm to the setting of the adjacent listed buildings and the character and appearance of the wider Bloomsbury Conservation area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Core Strategy; and DP24 (Securing high quality



design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
