I am writing to OBJECT to this application.

I object to the permission to display illuminated advertisements, which cram ever more commercial messages into our public spaces. We who live in Kentish Town are already bombarded by advertising of all sorts, and sizeable illuminated screens are not welcome additions to that visual load. Our public spaces are becoming precious, already invaded enough. We need no more.

I also object to the sheer size of this unit. It may be thin, but it is too tall. The application shows comparisons with other kinds of street furniture, and this unit with its internally illuminated screens, is the same height as a bus shelter, and is only exceeded by the street lights. It is too tall.

I object to this application and ask that it be rejected.
