					The proposals submitted will increase both the number of people using the site and the hours the site will be in use.
					I can find no suggestions which recognise and ameliorate the impact of this development and expansion on the local area or on the local residents. I did raise these objections at the "exhibition and consultation" which was organised by the developers and architect and wrote in as requested but received no reply (apart from an acknowledgment of receipt
					which I had to phone for).
					 My concerns include: Deliveries, get-ins/get-outs by bands - all take place at the Crowndale Road side entrance and regularly block the whole pavement making it impossible to pass. Parking on Crowndale Road by trucks/buses/delivery vehicles for long periods of time causing delays to traffic and making it both hazardous and difficult for cyclists - I am a cyclist. Containers of waste to be recycled also being left - usually leaking - on the same pavement, frequently overnight.
					I could not find the Design and Access Statement to check if these issues had been addressed - they hadn't when I raised them at the consultation.
					My objection is to an over development of the site both in proposed use and in the bulk of the building in Bayham Place. It appears that no consideration has been given to the residents, workers and people who are in Camden for a life outside KoKo and hotel - I request that this application be rejected until more thought is given on these issues.
