Summary of representations	a. The panels are not erected on a South-East facing roof, but on 2 East facing roofs where they will be much less efficient.							
(Officer response(s) in italics)	b. The roofs are too low and face the street, so are clearly visible and an eyesore in the middle of the Home Zone. That is clearly in contravention of the guidance issued by the Department of the Environment.							
	Summary of case officer's comments are as follows:							
	a. Roofs 1 and 2 that are referred to are not entirely eastward facing but							

also face southwards to some degree. It is therefore considered that the orientation of the roofs is accurately described as south-east facing. This orientation is considered to be adequate to allow for significant exposure to natural light.
