OBJECTION: CLEVELAND STREET WORKHOUSE SITE DEVELOPMENT

I wish to register my objection to the proposed plans for the Cleveland Street Workhouse site.

I am an academic working at University College Dublin. I specialise in nineteenth-century literature and culture, and I am publishing a book about urban development in London in the nineteenth century (*Dickens and Demolition*, forthcoming with Edinburgh University Press, 2018). It is my opinion that the Cleveland Street Workhouse site commands significant historical interest, and that the proposed redevelopment would materially damage an area that warrants full archaeological investigation.
