Ailanthus tree at the rear of the garden. It is badly overhanging on to the street (leighton Place) & have had many complaints from the neighbours having to walk & drive under it. The Landlord of Number 2 Leighton Place has written to me Saying the roots of the tree has caused cracks to the rear wall of his property & has lifted the tiles on the ground in front of his house. Cracks have also appeared in the tiling over his front door & inside his hallway. The tree is severely overhanging his property & is touching his windows & roof. The tree is also covered with Ivy & this has now embedded itself on his house & autters. he is very worried about the tree causing further structural damage to his house & the foundations.

The tree was planted in the garden before I took ownership of the property.

The tree needs to be completely felled & the roots killed off to halt any further damage to his property. See attached Plan T1
