Thanks for your amended drawings.

Please can I query the 'countdown timer' size as shown on pages 3 and 4 – The one currently at Russell Square would appear to be approximately this size and is clearly visible from outside the box, even across the road. We will need to condition the illumination level and would prefer it to be a lot smaller. Is it necessary for it to display time/numbering, i.e.) 00:00, when not in use?

Also; We require the shelving to be black the match the back plate and stool seat, so as to not stand out from a distance from the outside. I am sorry if this was not clear previously. It may also be necessary to condition the colour of the phone/ printer & scanner, so that these do not stand out. The examples shown are grey/ black which would be acceptable, but we would not want any garish or bright colours to replace these should they be upgraded at any point in the future.

And; if there is a proposed water cooler - it should be shown on the drawings. If not – it should be removed and any mention of 'tbc' should also be removed. There are some other items listed on Page 2 which I cannot identify on the plans? Where is the bin, the network controller, the router? Only items under consideration should be shown on the proposed plans.
