Existing Site Plan with detailed notes & dimensions showing demolition & excavation adjacent to trees.

All Existing Masonry Paving & Steps Removed
 • Topsoil laid over to marry levels to follow the profile of the existing lawn
 • All masonry carted away using manual wheelbarrows only.
 • During the demolition works suitable ground boarding is to be laid within all Root Protection Zones

Root protection zone shown shaded

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Stepping Stones:
 • ±35 mm of existing grass turf removed & new stepping stones laid on ±25 mm sand bed.

Existing Timber Shed Removed

Root protection zone shown shaded

New shed
 • Shed sited on existing, previously paved, level area
 • no-dig 75 mm Cellweb Tree Root Protection laid & filled with clean angular stone (type 4/20)
 • ± 25 mm (to levels) sand bedding
 • 50 mm porous stone paving setts laid over to form base for new shed
 • New shed built without foundations.

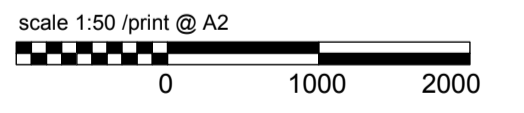
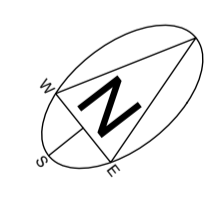

New Profile to Lawn
 • Excavation to reduce levels & form new profile to the existing lawn.
 • ± 150 mm of existing topsoil laid to new levels

Excavation to form permeable SUDS Pavement:
 • sharp gravel wrapped in geotextile soak-a-way under new stone pavers on sand bed
