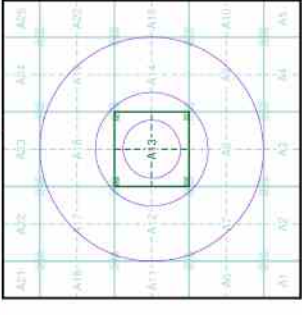
Urban Soil Chemistry Arsenic

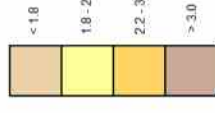

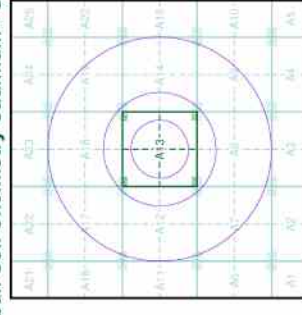
Urban Soil Chemistry Cadmium

Urban Soil Chemistry Cadmium - Slice A

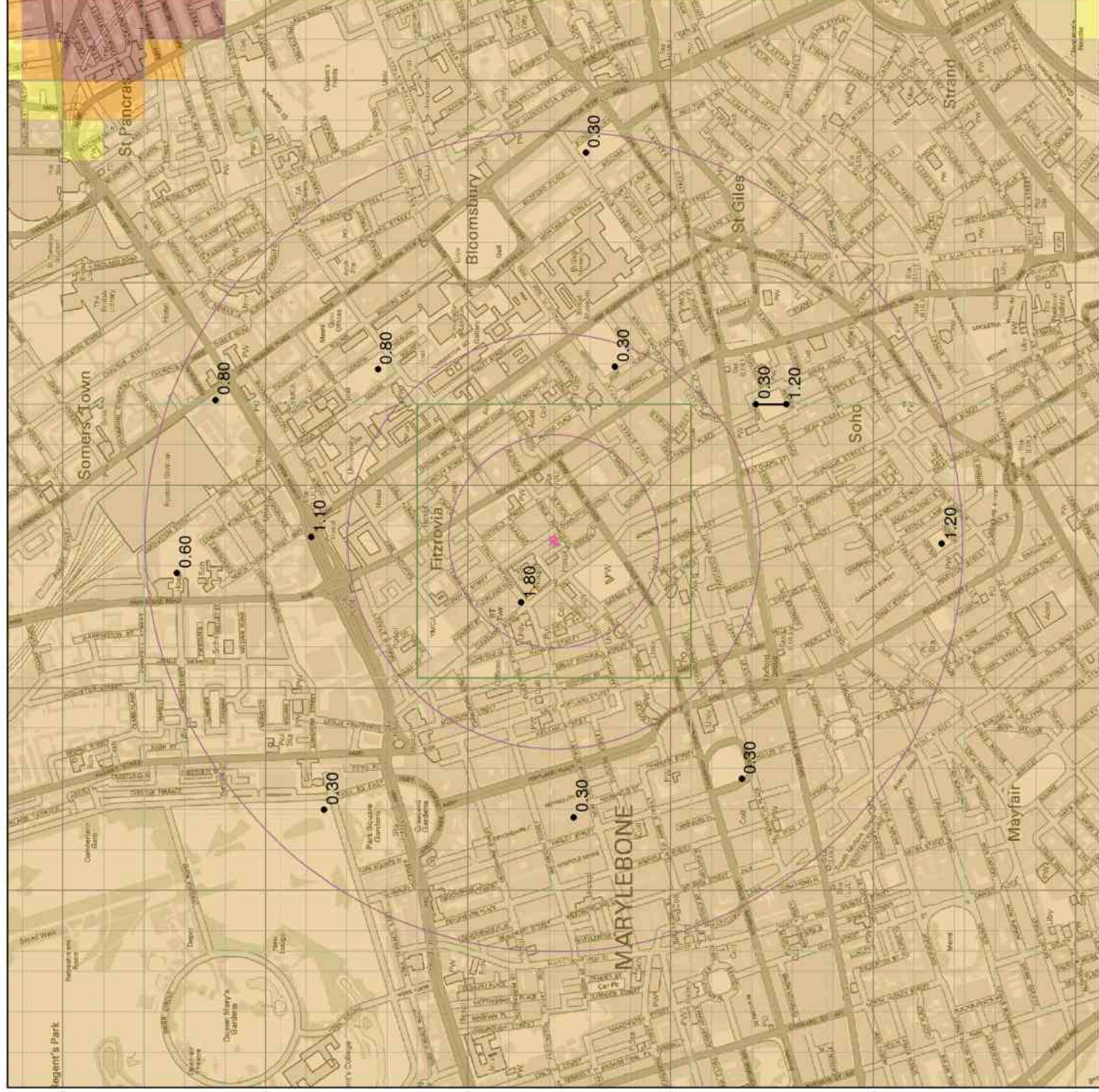

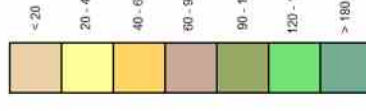

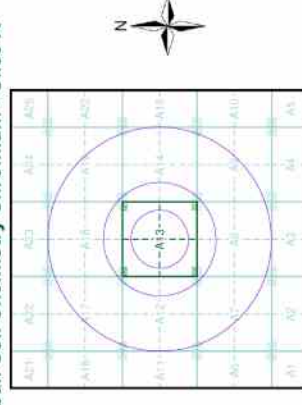

Urban Soil Chemistry Chromium - Slice A

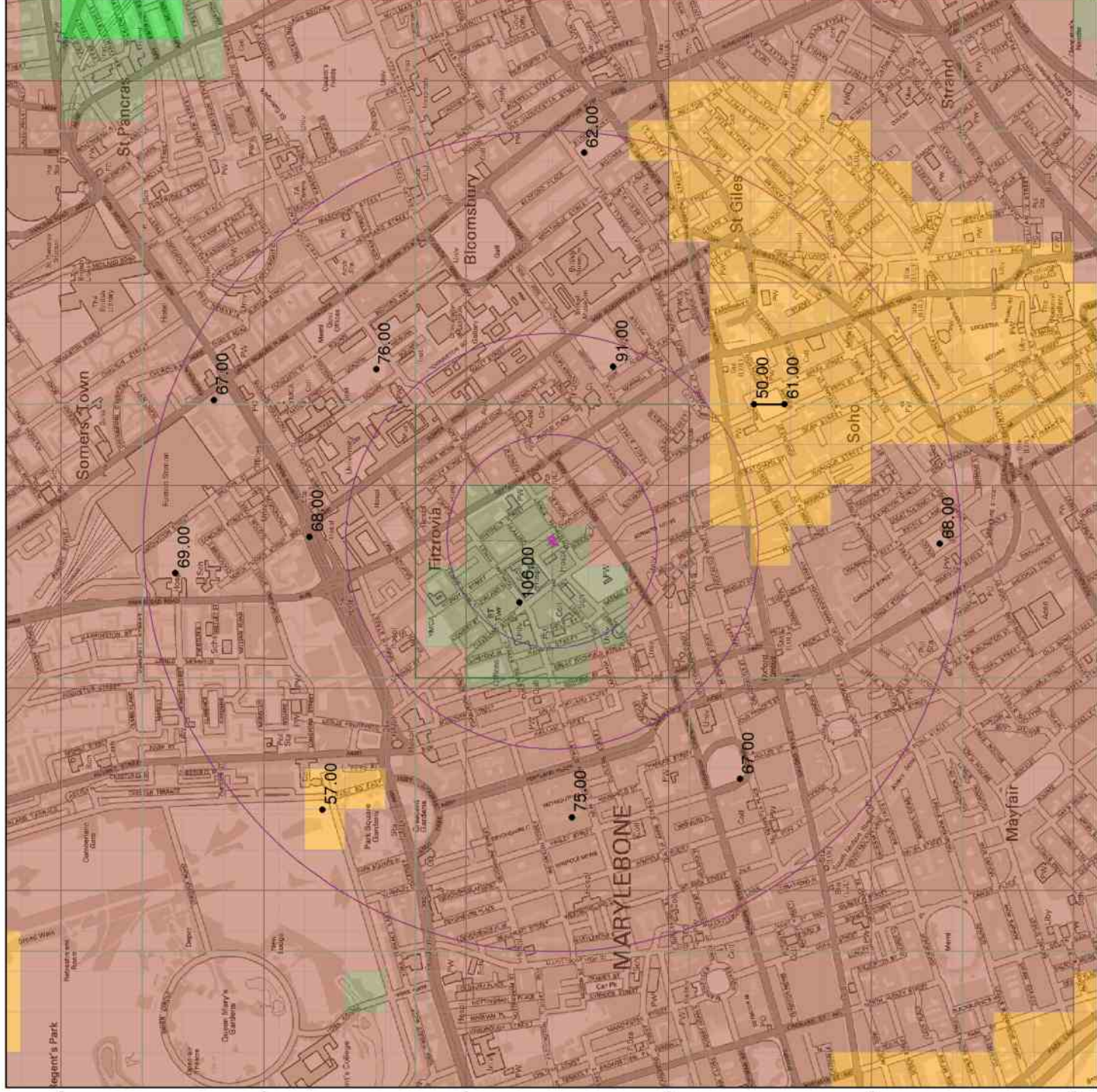

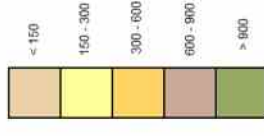

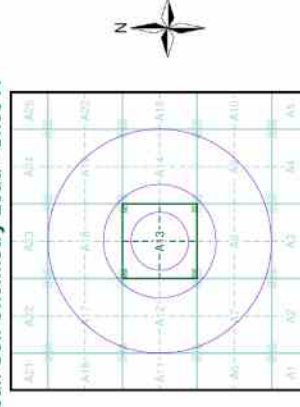

Urban Soil Chemistry Lead - Slice A

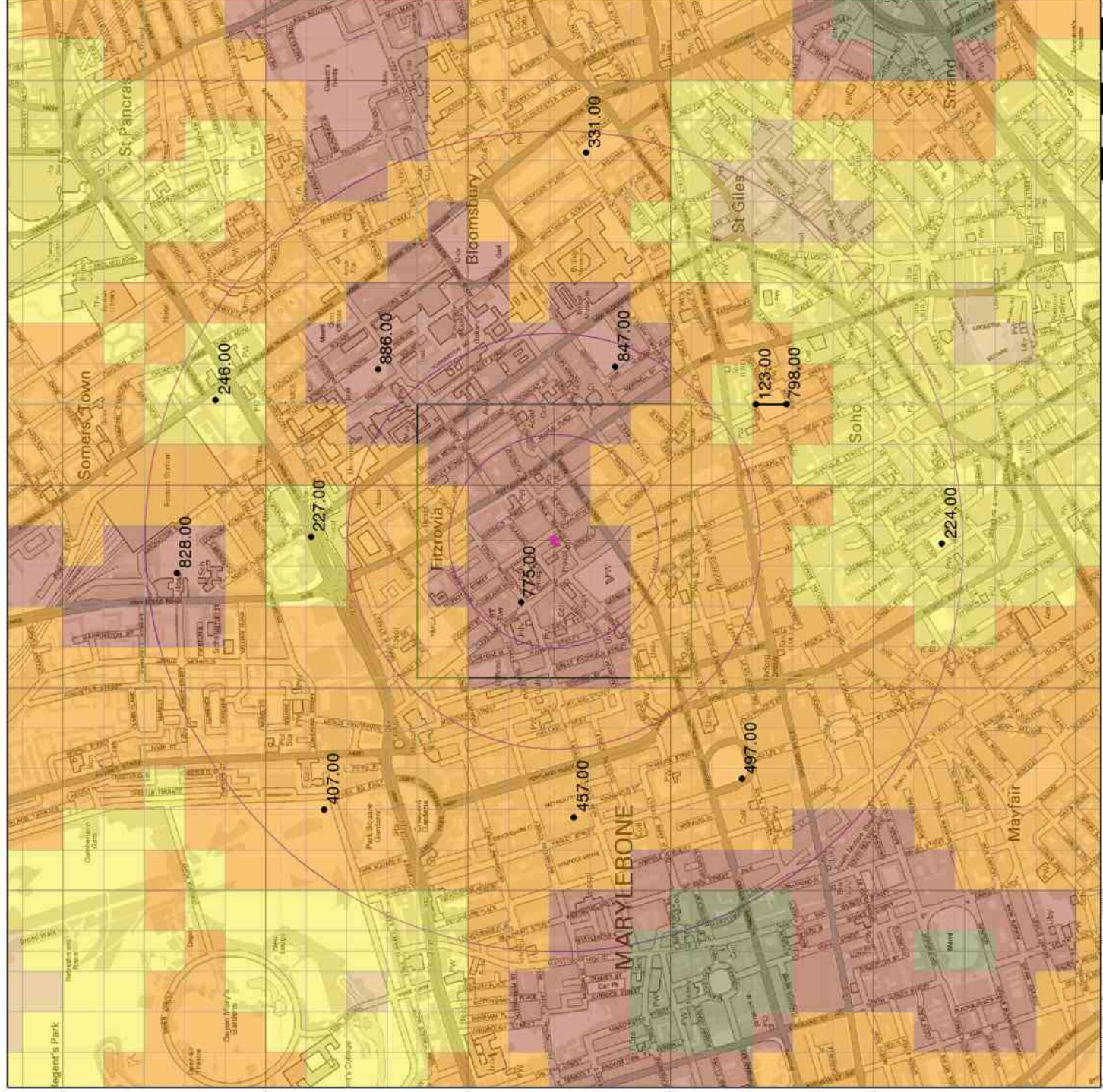

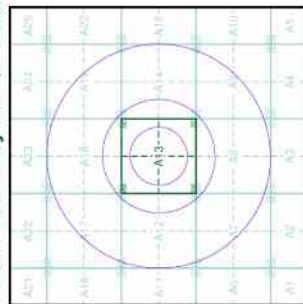

Urban Soil Chemistry Nickel - Slice A

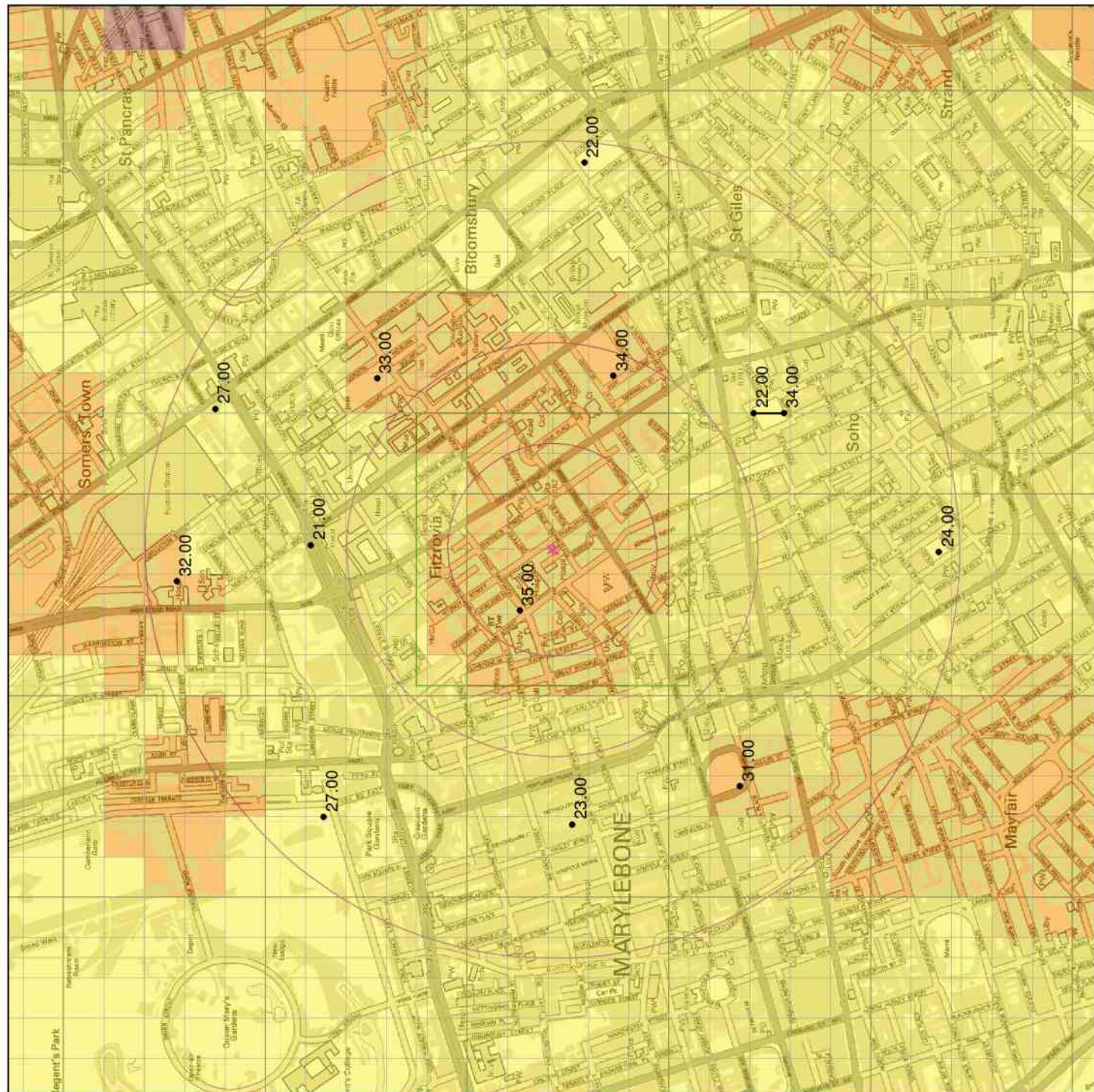

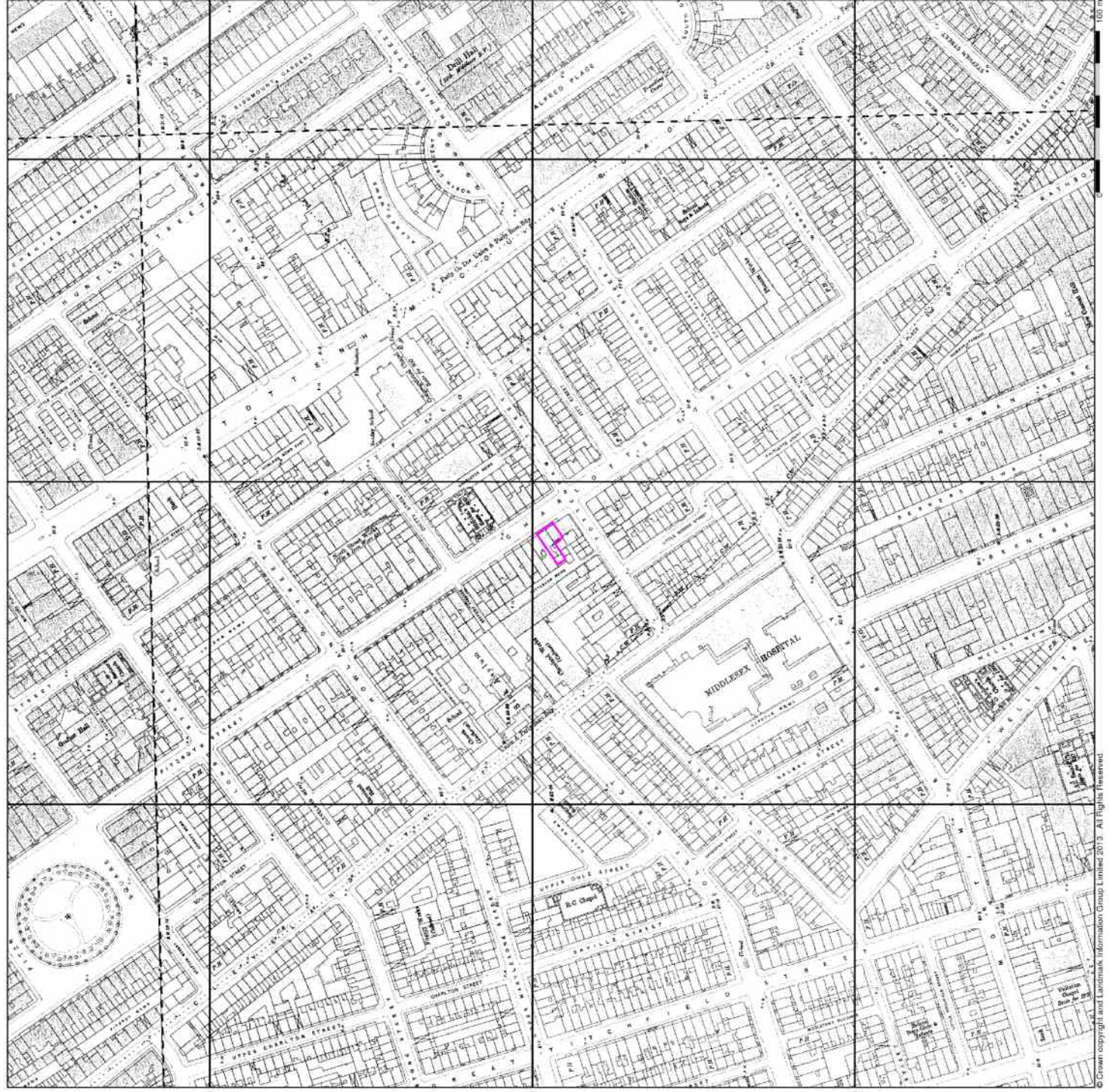

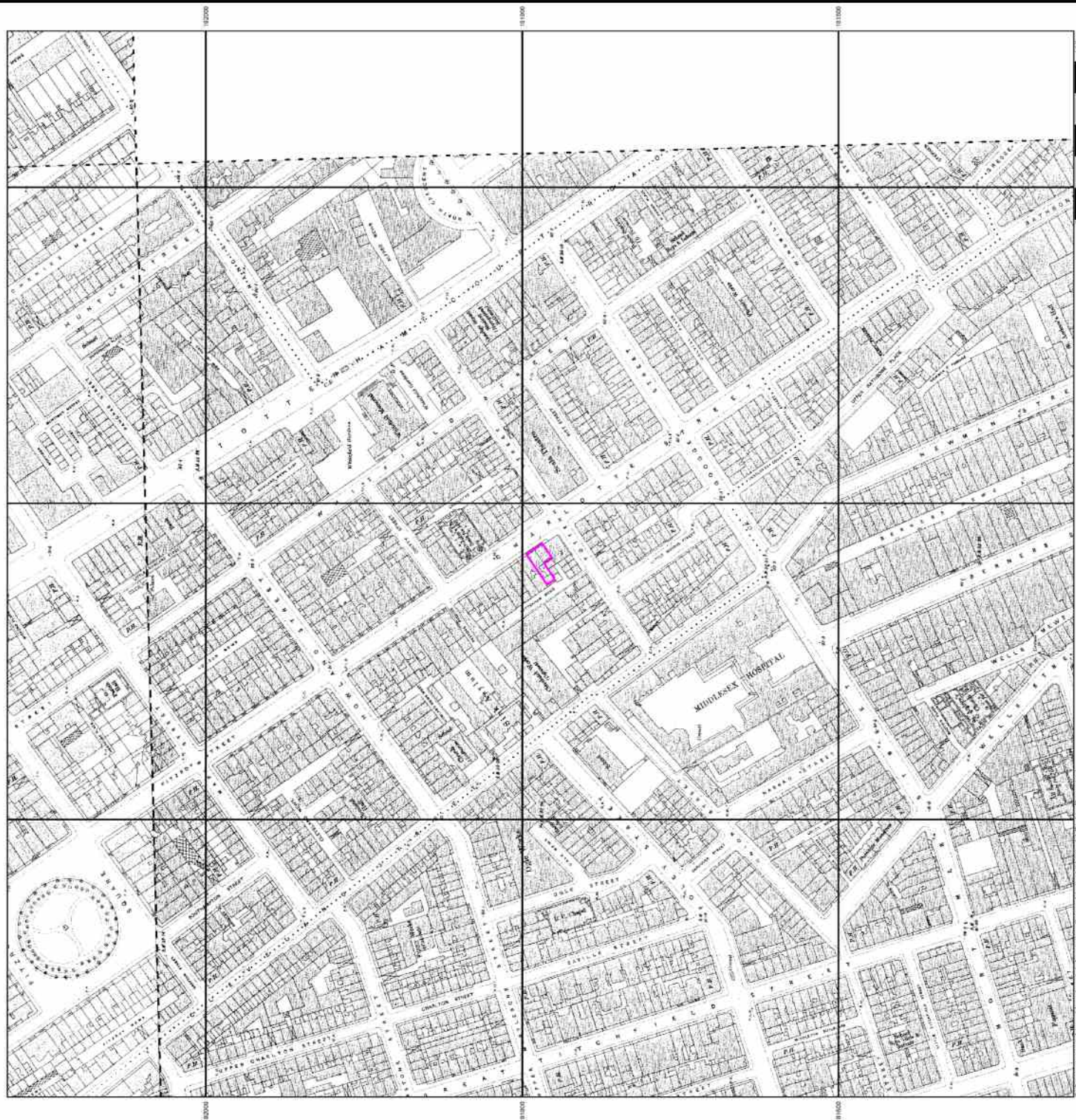

The historical town plans shown derive from Ordnance Survey mapping from the early to mid 1850s. The 1:5,280 scale was introduced in the early 1850s, to survey districts covered by the Local Boards of Health and for a map of the Ordnance Survey plan of Queen Victoria. The general style is similar to that of the 1:2500 scale plan of the mid 1840s, but the 1:5,280 scale was used for a more purpose mapping with a standard of content similar to the more contemporary 1:10,560 mapping. The scale was also used for a reduction of the 1:10,560 'sketch' survey of London that was undertaken between 1848 and 1850.

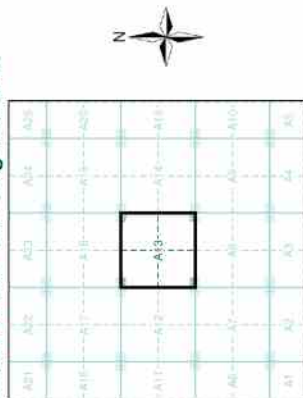

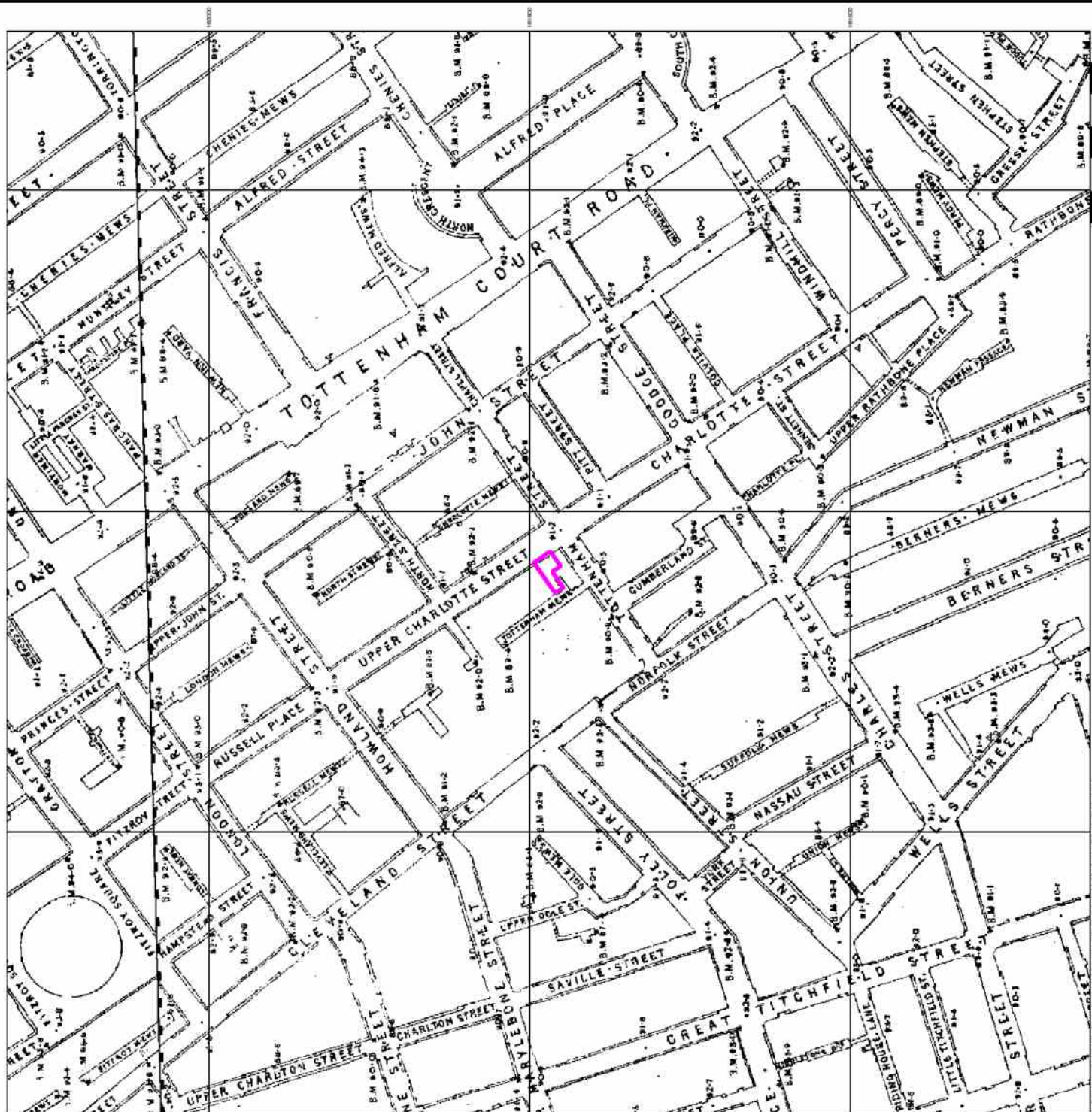

Index Map

For ease of identification, your site and buffer have been split into Slices, Segments and Quadrants. These are illustrated on the Index Map opposite and explained further below.

Slice

Each slice represents a 1:10,000 plot area (2.7m x 2.7m) for your site and buffer. A slice and buffer may be represented by a single letter (represented by a circle) that is referenced by the table of the alphabet, starting from the bottom left corner of the slice "grid". This grid does not relate to National Grid lines but is designed to give best fit over the site and buffer.

Segment

A segment represents a 1:2,500 plot area. Segments that have plot files associated with them are shown in dark green, others in light blue. These are numbered from the bottom left hand corner within each slice.

Quadrant

A quadrant is a quarter of a segment. These are labelled as NW, NE, SW, SE and are referenced in the datasheet to allow features to be quickly located on plots. Therefore a feature that has a quadrant reference of A7NW will be in Slice A, Segment 7 and the NW Quadrant.
