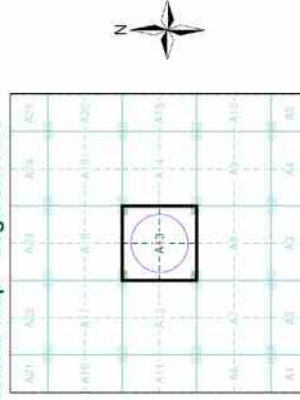

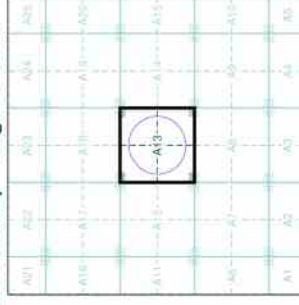

The historical maps shown were reproduced from maps predominantly held at the scale adopted for England, Wales and Scotland in the 1840's, in 1854 the 1:2,500 scale was adopted for mapping urban areas and by 1890 it Great Britain the whole of what was considered to be the cultivated parts of the country were covered by maps at this scale. It is often some years after the original survey date. Before 1938 the OS map is often based on the Cassini Projection, with independent surveys of a single county or group of counties, giving rise to significant inaccuracies in outlying areas.

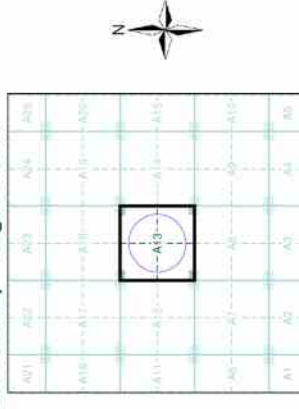

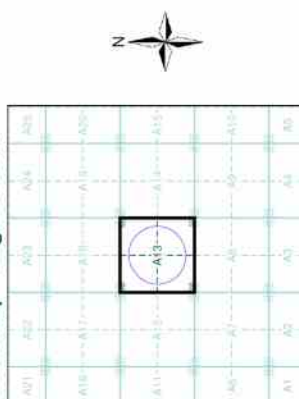

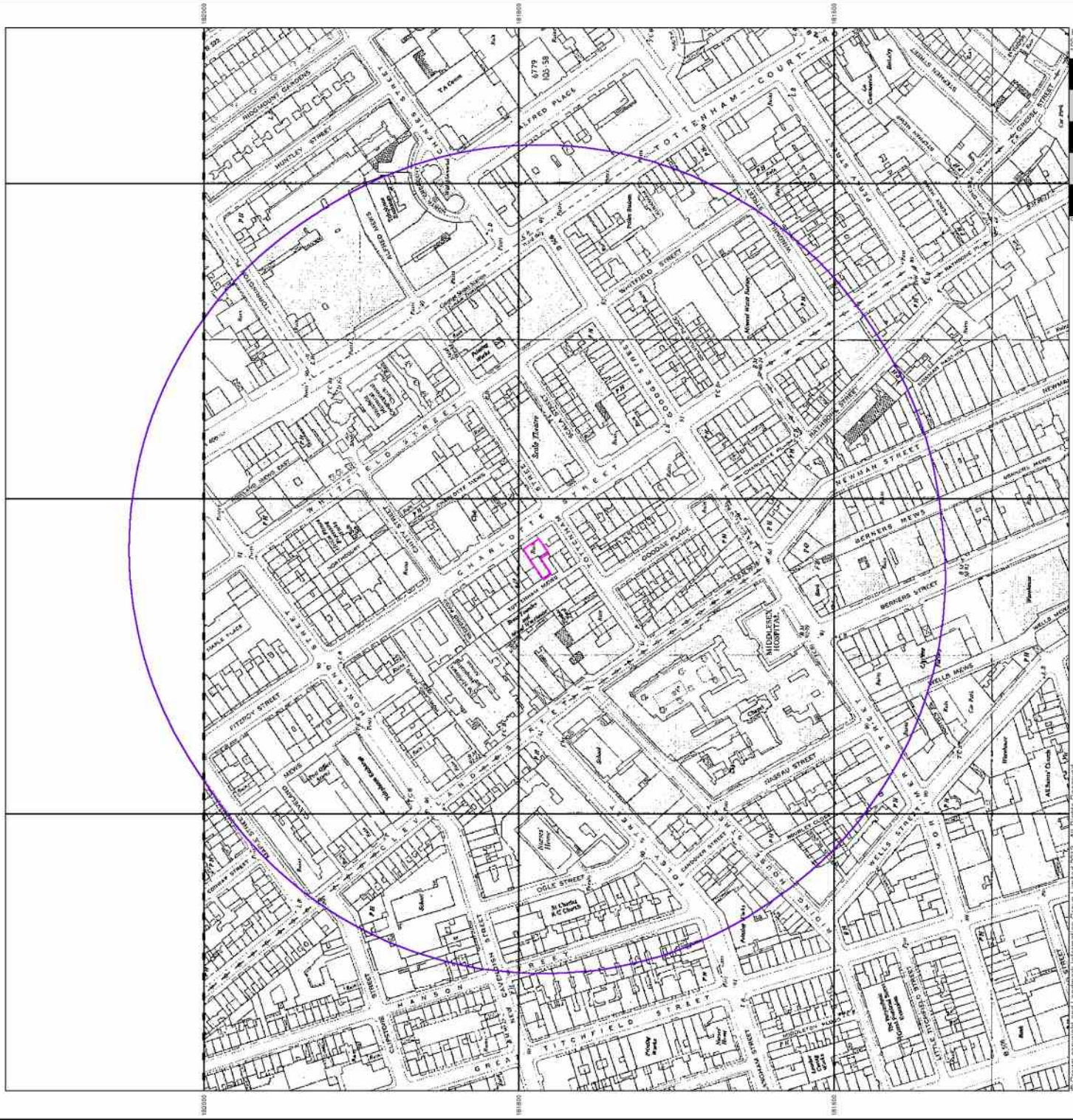

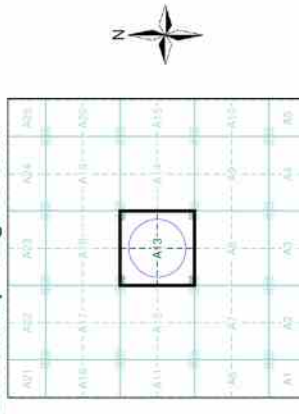

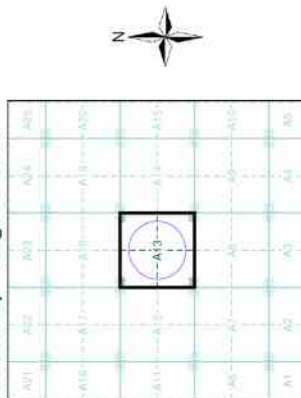

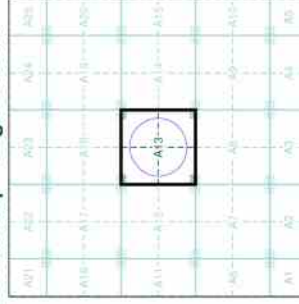

The maps were produced by the Ordnance Survey, which in the 1930s introduced the OS grid. The OS grid is often some years later than the original date. Before 1938 the OS grid was not used. The OS grid is a projection, with independent surveys of a single county or group of counties, giving rise to significant inaccuracies in outlying areas.

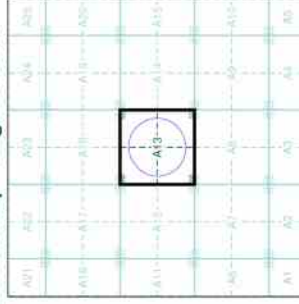

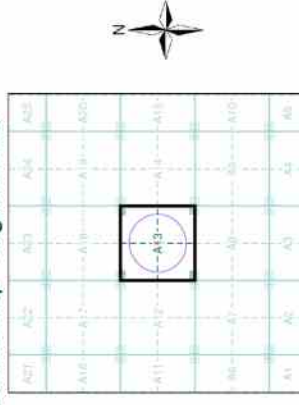
