Dear Ms Phillips,

- We are writing again to object to the proposed demolition and erection of a new dwelling your reference 2016/5380/P.
  - The building proposed is not at all in keeping with the area which has a feeling of space.
- The proposal for a new dwelling has much greater mass than the existing property. Despite being reduced from the original replacement proposal, it virtually abuts neighbouring structures.
- The house proposed will completely overpower the site in question and destroy a beautifully mellow area which overlooks an important crossroads in Hampstead.
- 4) We are not at all satisfied that the design is suitable or in keeping with a conservation area.
- 5) Mature trees will be lost to this structure and the proposed parking to the side elevation of Frognal Grove is
