T1. Fig- Reduce the height of 2 leading stems by 3 to 4m to prune back into the crown.

- Remove 1 large limb growing out over the gateway (this branch is rubbing against several others).

- Shorten 2 high overhanging limbs back from neighbouring property (Nash House). Reduce them back in to the crown removing 2 to 3m of growth.

- Crown thin by 25% removing mainly straight vigorous regrowths.
