Hi there Matthias! My name is Miss Amanda Burrell and i reside at Waites court. NW6 3BD. My housing association is Octavia housing. Agent is Leonard Trigell Associates. Application number 2017/0052/P This is a trail one email as it failed numerous times yesterday and today so i will send another email with attachments of my garden.

I understand you are the officer in charge of this application. I would like to bring to your attention that it was in fact myself that came up with this whole proposal of erecting the existing fences at Waites court which is on a main road. I have people stop right outside my home and talk or just look in or forever conveniently park outside a massive tree right outside mines! (which i may also do another application in the future for to cut it omg it's massive and sooo many leaves fall all in my garden lol) But back to the application at hand, people have even grabbed my cat deterrents and chucked them outside the garden once until the caretaker saw them and kindly returned them to me one morning. (antisocial behavior as people were using my newly done garden for their walking dogs!) My fear is, what next. My garden leads straight to my lounge/kitchen area. All the 3 bedrooms are at the back of the flats. So i sometimes have panic attacks thinking how i'll get to my special needs son next door to me if someone breaks in as well as his twin further own the hall of the flat! and run through the front door.. It's really scary. And there were a few crimes last year in the area. When i first moved here three years ago, a drug dealer jumped over the fence next door (well i assumed he was on drugs) as he looked rough and was searching the floor frantically on the ground like he threw a stash of drugs (to hide) or something and couldn't find it. I immediately but quietly shut my kitchen window. I was surprised he didn't hear. Too high i suppose. O\_o. The existing fences is only 1 meter, some parts 1.2 meters high, EASY to climb over. I'm a mum of two (twins) I've never seen an aluminium fence so small. One of the twins's who is disabled, the other is fine, his social worker, key worker, community nurses are all shocked by the lack of security. The garden space is nice and a real shame it can't be used. I took the flat hoping for my special needs son to enjoy outside, as he is a wheelchair user and can't weight bare so it makes him sad sometimes seeing other kids his age kick a ball or run around, as he can't, and he loves football



. I designed him a football bedroom now. This was my drive to move as we lived on a 2nd floor flat before for 8 years, lovely, but impracticable in the end. We were outside a lovely big park up Camden road, Canteloves park. I always lay out there in the sun, as my *\*get away\** and just lay my special needs son next to me. I would do picnics, birthday parties.. It really keeps our anxieties at bay. I have to carry him everywhere. Being a young carer has lead me to big anxieties where sometimes i just need to "escape" and being able to just run outside in my front garden would be very relaxing for me believe it or not. ie just watching the stars at night will literally give me LIFE! (lol), but right now i refuse to due to the lack of security, as well as having to flee a violent relationship in the past and being found still to this day

heightens my anxieties. I have forwarded what my front garden looks onto, and what i could turn it into. I love interior design.

I understand that Iftkar based at Leonard Trigell associates is in charge of sending this application on, but it came to my attention on February 15th of this year, that he has NOT emphasized that i proposed Bamboo fencing. It is important you are aware of this as i'm sure it instantly changes the whole dynamics of the situation which is far from complicated. Bamboo fencing only comes in 1.5 meter high or 1.8 meter high (6 foot) I proposed 6 foot as my housing was confusing me between the different communications questioning why i chose 1.6 meters originally.. This application was first seen to last year August 2016, where my housing came to my home to take pictures, measurements and forward you guys, where i even printed all the bamboo screening ideas to be forwarded to your office. LOST! So i am willing to negotiate and settle with **1.5 meters high**. I am 5'7 and a half tall so **1.5 meter high** for a tall person is waist length. Or i can buy the **tall 1.8 meter (6 foot high one)** and leave it IF YOU AGREE, OR get it cut down by professional handy men to **1.6 meters high** (my other proposal), if you like also. **1.6 meters high** you're looking at belly button length lol. Only the odd couple 6 footers walk by sometimes, so that's alright. Yep i'm doing ALL my research lol. If your office would be more comfortable with that, than the proposed 6 foot, (1.8 meters, 180cm, then i am fine with it! So you have a few options to discuss with your staff i suppose and see which ones fits you. I will be buying the bamboo myself. I have contacted the companies and has found them for cheap in Europe to be shipped down less than 130 euros for my width of 7.7 meters across of 1.5 meter height. This will include buying x3 lots and galvanized wire to attach. So as you can see it will not affect the building works, or grounds, plus it is only temporary and a wind protector, privacy protector, and also beautiful. PLEASE take time to read this email and take into account my proposal with your office. Show them the attachments. I made sure I forwarded you this until the final decision scheduled for March, perhaps April. One will also be able to add fake hedging over the bamboo fencing as they do have specific heights . I have also attached the artificial hedging i will like to opt for also, as me and the boys has allergies, and real hedging attracts wasps and birds (sigh), plus the hedging will have to be put outside our fence and therefore be maintained by the housing group **Octavia** as the hedging could outgrow overtaking the pavement walkway where people pass, and just outside the aluminium fence is not classed as "our property" We would have to actually leave the main block to maintain any hedge proposal. I know the remaining flats are disabled people, but i am a carer for my young son which has lead me to back problems. Please consider this application with great care and thought. The whole of Hampstead / West Hampstead is full of high fencing etc. Even the "rich house" as i like to call it right opposite (a few footsteps away, but more towards my left, before the council block which is in view in the attached pics) has high alluminium fencing, and i'm sure an application was agreed for that.
