



Site Survey and Pest Control monitoring/treatment plan
65/69 Holmes rd. London. NW5 3AN

A walk through visit was carried out today 06/01/2017. No evidence of pest activity was found at time of visit. No gnawing, burrowing, smear marks, droppings or evidence of insect activity apparent in the areas inspected.

In order to maintain this pest free environment I propose monthly routine visits by a qualified pest control technician.

Metal tamper proof bait stations should be placed throughout the site containing non-toxic bait. These will assist, but by no means be the only form of monitoring. The technician will inspect the entire site for any potential or actual pest issues. If pests are detected this monthly regime will increase and the appropriate pesticide will be deployed as required.

The ever changing environment of a building site may also dictate increased regularity of visits. Barratt and Sons provide a call out service should our assistance be required at any time.

Due to the nature of building sites, rodents are their most common problem. With this in mind all pest control monitoring and treatment is carried out in line with the rodenticide code of best practise, provided by the campaign for responsible rodenticide use, in order to negate any risk to Non-target animal species.

A Written report documenting all findings and actions will be provided at the end of every visit. Should Pesticides be used all relevant risk assessment, Coshh assessment and method statements will be provided.
