During my walk around the circuit I didn't see one of the ten boxes in use - only people on their mobiles. I understand that a business wants to expand but at the expense of public space that is already cluttered and for a little used service it is unreasonable and these two applications and the one at the corner of Finchley road and Adelaide Road (not a pedestrian route) should be refused.</p>
