Although in the past some of the large houses on Ftizjohns Avenue have had thier front gardens destroyed to provide parking any further desecration of the existing gardens should be resisted . The whole 'green' character of Fitzjohns Avenue would be further eroded by this application 2. If an application were to be granted then this would set a clear precedent for more front gardens to be destroyed . 3. Camden should discourage car use in the borough, the application's location is particularly well served by public transport, (at least 6 bus routes and 3 tube lines are within a 5 min walk from the property .)
