Proposal:

Details of green roof, as required by condition 4 of planning permission ref 2015/1507/P (dated 22/10/2015) for the erection of a side infill lower ground extension with terrace at upper ground floor area, conversion of existing vaults into habitable rooms and a single storey rear outbuilding.

Drawing Nos: MOR 651, Bauder Vegetation for Extensive & Biodiverse Green Roofs, sedum roof maintenance plan.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission.

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The application seeks to discharge condition 4 of planning permission ref. 2015/1507/P relating to details of the green roof and a scheme of maintenance,



associated with the approved garden building. The details submitted propose a mix of Bauder UK Provenance Native Species plug plants, planted within in a substrate of an acceptable depth. A programme for a scheme of maintenance is sufficiently detailed and is acceptable in terms of supporting the long term viability of the green roof.

The details are therefore considered to be in accordance with policies CS13, CS15 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP22, DP23 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
