## **DECISION**

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)

### **Full Planning Permission Granted**

Installation of metallic railings to doors and windows on the rear elevation to office building  
(Class B1).

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission subject to the following condition(s):

Condition(s) and Reason(s):

- 1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).



- 2 All new external work shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing building, unless otherwise specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

- 3 The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the following approved plans:

Lo37\_A\_G200\_XE\_00; Lo37\_A\_G200\_E\_02 Rev C; Site location plan.

Reason:

For the avoidance of doubt and in the interest of proper planning.

#### Informative(s):

- 1 Reasons for granting permission:

The proposed railings to doors and windows would be of black powder coated steel frame at an unequal steel angle. The doors would have a secure 3mm flat key plate covered by coloured laser cut powder coated plate screen within frame to conceal security panel with panic bar door release behind.

Even though the main purpose of the proposed railings to doors and windows is to secure the existing office building, it is considered that the design of the railings would respond in a positive manner to the character and appearance of the existing office building. It is therefore considered that the proposed railings would not cause any significant harm to the character of the existing building, street scene or neighbouring properties or amenities.

No objections have been received prior to making this decision. The planning history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, with particular regard to policy CS14, and the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies, with particular regard to policies DP24 and DP26 and policy D1 of the Camden Local Plan Submission Draft 2016. The proposed development also accords with London Plan 2016 and National Planning Policy Framework 2012.

- 2 The emerging Camden Local Plan is reaching the final stages of its public examination. Consultation on proposed modifications to the Submission Draft Local Plan began on 30 January and ends on 13 March 2017. The modifications have

been proposed in response to Inspector's comments during the examination and seek to ensure that the Inspector can find the plan 'sound' subject to the modifications being made to the Plan. The Local Plan at this stage is a material consideration in decision making, but pending publication of the Inspector's report into the examination only has limited weight.

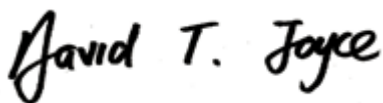
- 3 Your proposals may be subject to control under the Building Regulations and/or the London Buildings Acts which cover aspects including fire and emergency escape, access and facilities for people with disabilities and sound insulation between dwellings. You are advised to consult the Council's Building Control Service, Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street WC1H 8EQ, (tel: 020-7974 6941).
- 4 Noise from demolition and construction works is subject to control under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. You must carry out any building works that can be heard at the boundary of the site only between 08.00 and 18.00 hours Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 13.00 on Saturday and not at all on Sundays and Public Holidays. You are advised to consult the Council's Compliance and Enforcement team [Regulatory Services], Camden Town Hall, Argyle Street, WC1H 8EQ (Tel. No. 020 7974 4444 or on the website <http://www.camden.gov.uk/ccm/content/contacts/council-contacts/environment/contact-the-environmental-health-team.en> or seek prior approval under Section 61 of the Act if you anticipate any difficulty in carrying out construction other than within the hours stated above.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
