The Brick manufacturer is Michelmersh and the brick is Freshfield First Quality Multi Red Light Texture Clay Brick 65mm.



The pointing will be done in a silver sand and cement mortar to match the mortar of the brickwork at No.15 Well Road.

The details have been assessed by the Conservation Officer and are considered acceptable and appropriate in the surrounding conservation area. The condition can therefore be discharged.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the conservation area, under s.72 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
