Maintenance Schedule – 32 Jamestown Road

The site will be attended throughout a 12-month period by uniformed staff. A record of all maintenance visits will be provided for each visit to the client with a signed acknowledgement of attendance. Our Exterior Manager / Supervisor will carry out regular quality audit visits and advise of any improvements and provide costs if required.

Green Roofs	Top Level (6 th) – 20sqm 5 th Floor – 70sqm 4 th Floor – 105sqm
Description of Plant	ing
Containerised Climbing Plants	 1st & 2nd Floor Balconies and 4th & 5th Floor Rear Terraces – Planted with <i>Hedera helix</i> (ivy) 4th & 5th Floor Terraces Front – Planted with <i>Trachleospermum jasminoides</i> (Star Jasmine) These will be 10L pot planted specimens (except for on balconies 1&2) and will be planted approx every 35cm along the troughs. Granula expanded clay balls will be used as a drainage layer to approx. 50mm and a multi-purpose compost will be used as the growing medium.

Proposed Works &	Service Frequency
Containerised Climbing Plants	 Watering – All containers will be watered by a fitted Automatic Watering system except for 1st & 2nd Floor Balconies which will be watered manually. Feeding – An all-purpose liquid fertiliser will be applied to the planters twice a year at the start and midway through the growing season. Pruning – Hard prune in Spring and then a lighter prune to tidy after flowering. Pest Control – Pesticide will be applied in accordance with manufacturer's instructions to keep the planting healthy. Soil levels - will be topped up as required to ensure the planters are full to within 5cm of the top of the container. Weed control – Weeds will be removed from the containers manually. Service Frequency – 19 visits per year (Out of Hours tbc?)
Green Roofs	 Watering – Only required during very dry periods (more than 2 weeks without rain) manually using a hose. Weed control – Twice a year the invasive weeds will be removed from the roof manually. Cutting of Grasses/Wildflowers – (if present) this will be carried out Oct/Nov and debris removed from site. Drainage Outlets will be checked to ensure they are clear. Service Frequency – 4 visits per year depending on planting (Out of Hours tbc?)
H&S Precautions	Long Arm pruners will be used to cut back the climbers wherever possible to prevent risks involved using ladders on terraces. Where the Green roofs are not enclosed a fall restraint system must be in place. Our operatives will be fully trained in this, all associated safety certificates will be checked prior to any work taking place in these areas.

All pesticide applications will be carried out in accordance with current legislation, the COSHH assessment and the manufacturer's instructions.
