We are writing to you regarding the intended work to trees in the camden arts center garden. We live in 5 lindfield gardens and our garden backs onto the camden arts center's grounds.

We are completely against the work planned, as it will directly affect us in the following way:

- Security: The trees create a natural barrier for anyone trying to come through our garden via the camden arts center. We have been burgled via that route once before and believe the more trees are in the way, the better.
- View: If trees are cut back or taken down, visitors will be able to see through into our garden and accommodation, which can again create a security issue.
