One Tilia in the rear garden of the coach house nw3 9qb has excessive movement in high winds. It has previously been reduced heavily and as a result has lost its natural shape and stands out as an eyesore in an otherwise tree friendly area. The proposal is to remove and replant for the reasons above. I propose to dismantle the tree and replant a mature magnolia gradiflora within 12 feet of the existing tree. The replacement would be approximately 5 meters tall and would be more consistent with the natural look of hamstead
