Gallery 42 north façade where openings will be made in existing blind windows (currently faced with stock brick); south and west courtyard (white glazed brick) for new window openings.

Sandstone, slate perimeter with intermittent cast iron grill to heating trench; timber strip flooring supported on joists & bearers.

New slate border with continuous cast iron grille to relocated heating trench. Slate supported by new bedding/screed/void filler substrate. Hardwood strip flooring in the centre of both galleries supported on joists & bearers. In Galleries 43-45, new steel beams for strengthening the existing floor are required at areas of weak capacity. Generally new steelwork is required for supporting central showcases. Floor box finish will match their locations (slate or timber) with metal trim.
