Demolition of walls and bridge area to the rear and creation of a rear courtyard area with winter garden and ground floor rear extension, creation of first floor and fourth floor terraces, plant (condenser units) at roof level and amalgamation of second and third floor flats into a two bed self-contained flat (C3).

Recommend No Archaeological Requirement

Thank you for your consultation dated 28 March 2017.

The Greater London Archaeological Advisory Service (GLAAS) provides archaeological advice to boroughs in accordance with the National Planning Policy Framework and GLAAS Charter.

Having considered the proposals with reference to information held in the Greater London Historic Environment Record and/or made available in connection with this application, I conclude that the proposal is unlikely to have a significant effect on heritage assets of archaeological interest.



Although the site lies within an Archaeological Priority Area the works are too small scale to be likely to cause significant harm in this location.

No further assessment or conditions are therefore necessary.
