<<< For a full planning application, only a single set of proposals can be consider (only one option). Given that a white timber framed window of the kind shown would likely benefit from permitted development regulations, and if so, not need planning permission, I would need to put forward your proposals as a white metal framed window. This would likely be refused given that the proposed material would not be in accordance with guidance and policies as they advise that where timber is the traditional window material, new or replacements should also be in timber frames.

I therefore advise you to consider the above and confirm which material you would like to be considered. The choice is entirely up to you and I wait to be advised how you wish to proceed. However, I would suggest altering your application to a certificate of lawfulness application for a proposed timber window so that this can be determined. If this is lawful, then you are still in a position to consider at a later date whether you want to make a further application for full planning permission with regard to a metal or frameless window and have this formally determined.
