This firm acts on behalf of the owner of 3 Belsize Place, Belsize Park, London NW3 5AL which directly abuts the rear of the Property.

The Application seeks to fell a single sycamore tree located in the rear garden of the Property which is stated to be 'due to severance and decay' of the tree. Despite our client's immediate proximity to the subject tree, notice of the Application was not given to our client nor was it included in the list of neighbours consulted (see attached). Our client has only just become aware of this Application and strongly objects to the proposal on the following grounds:

'Severance and decay'

Please see the attached report from Landmark Trees in relation to this tree. Two site monitoring visits were carried within the last 4 months to inspect this tree (16 December 2016 and January 2017). At both times there was no sign of any root severance having occurred. Furthermore, it was noted that there were no defects within the tree, and that its structural condition was good. The report concludes that "...even if there were some decay present within the tree that was not visible to me during my original survey or site monitoring visit...sycamores are renowned for dealing with decay well".

Residential amenity

As the Council is aware, this tree is located in the Belsize Conservation Area and as such it makes an important contribution to its character, which is the very reason it is given special protection.

There are few trees in the rear gardens of this Conservation Area, and this tree in particular provides welcome screening between the Property and our client's property. Removal of this tree would cause harm to our client's amenity and is strongly resisted.

Based on the evidence enclosed with this letter, there is no valid justification to allow this tree to be felled. However, even if there was to be some decay, this should be managed, rather than permitting the tree to be destroyed. The benefits the tree provides to the conservation area and residential amenity warrant that all reasonable measures are taken to protect and maintain this tree.

The Council is respectfully requested to refuse this application and to keep this firm apprised of any decision the Council reaches on this matter.
