Our concerns are that the proposal made does not take account of the steep fall of the garden away from our house and that the size of the extension is not sympathetic to the current garden environment. At 4m from the house (the proposed length of the extension), the current decking is approximately 0.6m above the garden, meaning the extension will be 3.7m high. This is not shown in any of the drawings attached to the application. The current pergola is lower than the balcony at the house and dips down, so as well as being longer, the extension would be higher - and solid wall, rather than trellis and wysteria. It is not clear what height the existing fence would be for people standing on the extended decking as the garden falls further.
