As your address is in the Dartmouth Park Conservation Area, any tree with a stem diameter of 75mm (or more) when measured at a height of 1.5m is protected by default and the council must be notified (and not object to) any tree works before they are carried out. We then have six weeks to make a decision as to whether to object to the proposed works or not.
