It appears the applicants are aware that the amended design still does not fit in with the local character of the area hence not providing a fair comparison. Following your previous comments in relation to this application, I am emailing to inform you that the application is being re-consulted due to changes to the design of the proposal.

The description of development now reads:

Erection of 2 storey roof extension with garden room and terrace at rooftop level; creation of 2 x 2 bedroom flats.

The changes to the previous scheme include:

- ∞ increased set-backs at 6th and 7th floor level,
- ∞ the introduction of a projecting parapet lip at 5th floor level,
- ∞ changes to fenestration design,
- ∞ enlarging of garden room at roof level, and
- ∞ reduction in size of roof terrace.
