Dear Sirs:

I have been made aware of the planning application listed above on behalf of the Antalya restaurant. **I am writing to you to object to this application.**

As a resident living near the Antalya, we suffer the problems from lack of proper extractor fans and the smell of cooking from this restaurant. This is especially problematical during summer months when we all have our windows open against the heat, and our living spaces smell of grilled and barbequed meats.

I appeared with Val Marchant at the original hearing when Camden granted a license for this restaurant to open and to operate. Many of the concerns that we raised and for which restrictions were put in place have not been actioned by the restaurant nor enforced by Camden.

Valerie and David Marchant have lodged an objection against this application and have gone into great detail about past and present concerns. They have spoken in greater detail and with greater technical knowledge than I am capable of doing, but I echo and endorse all that they have said.

From the first presentation of the original application, we were all concerned about food smells, noise, smokers outside the building at the back. These are still issues of concern and will be more so if this application is granted.

The Antalya restaurant is located in an area with much residential property around it. The impact of granting this application will have a negative effect on a vast number of residents who live in proximity to this venue.
