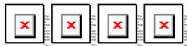

Our objection is:

The whole area is within the Camden designated '*Highgate Village*' Conservation area and in recognition of the special contribution of trees, nationwide conservation area legislation introduced in 1967 includes the blanket protection of all trees having a stem diameter greater than 75mm (3 inches) when measured at 1.5 metres (5 feet) above ground level.

Secondly we fully support Camden's Policy regarding trees which sees them as having the following benefits:

- ∞ Improving air quality, micro-climate characteristics and mitigating the 'urban heat island' effect
- ∞ Providing aesthetic, mental health and social benefits
