Full details of all new window and door openings have been submitted as per the wording of the condition along with samples and details of the facing materials to be used on the extension. The submitted details are considered to be satisfactory to formally partially discharge the condition.

The window and door details would ensure a high quality nature of the approved design and retain sufficient depth and interest to the elevations. Therefore, they



would maintain the character and appearance of the host building and surrounding area. The sample panel and details of the brickwork would be appropriate to match the host building.
