A similar application from Waldon Telecom was turned down by the Planning Committee in October 2016. The revamped application is considerably more intrusive than the original, consisting of three mast structures on Troyes House instead of the single structure of the original application. Camden Council is supposed to protect the interests of local residents, so why they are supporting another application so soon after over 100 residents objected to the original, raises serious questions. The original application was turned down because it 'would fail to preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the conservation area'. There is also real concern amongst the residents of Troyes House about the health effects on vulnerable people of living so close to a powerful source of electro magnetic radiation. Vodafone and O2 – who have a mast sharing agreement – have excellent coverage in the area, partucularly since antennae were recently installed on Cayford House, apparently without planning consent.
					This is a vexatious and injurious application and should be refused. The Council must also take steps to ensure that local residents are not troubled again.
