It attractively breaks up the uniformity of the terraced houses and gardens. It is sufficiently well developed to be clearly visible by the public between the end of terraces in both roads. The tree has been pruned to a height of about 5m but is in healthy condition and it is growing well this year after the removal of an adjacent Bay tree. Felling the Silver Birch would be a loss to the communal area of gardens. I believe the main reason why the proposal has been submitted, is the mess made by pigeons on the paving of the back garden of 25 Courthope Road. This is not an adequate reason for removing an attractive tree.
