I visited yesterday. The Elder is self-seeded; from the large parent tree in the garden. It is growing rapidly and will soon be out-competed by adjacent trees.

It is also too near to the garden shed. The tenant gardeners (Circle 33) have planted a pear and apple and intend to plant a magnolia nearby to fill the space left by the elder's removal. Many of the tenants support its removal. I think that the pear, apple and proposed magnolia will have more amenity value, especially to the tenants (!), than another elder which is expensive to maintain.
